June: InterFaith Works Refugee Resettlement Refugee Resettlement handles the tasks of helping recently arrived clients establish their new lives in Central New York. This is accomplished by assisting refugees with a variety of basic needs such as arranging for housing, essential furnishings and food; providing seasonal clothing as needed; enrolling adults in English classes and children in school; ensuring that necessary medical care is received (including health screenings); assisting with applications for social security cards and appropriate benefits such as food stamps and cash assistance. The center also provides interpretation as needed for all the services provided as well as cultural orientation to help clients learn about life in their new home. The program has settled refugees for more than 30 years and receives an average of 500 refugees annually from countries such as Afghanistan, Burma, Bhutan, Cuba Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Iraq, Somalia, Sudan and the Ukraine. Refugee Resettlement works to encourage the community to come together with new families and welcome them. We provide opportunities for faith and civic groups to assist families and work with over 75 faith partners and groups.
