### MISSION OF THE MONTH

## August: HOPE for Ariang

HOPE for Ariang partners with communities to provide inclusive access to quality education and opportunities for children and youth in Ariang, South Sudan. To reduce the barriers to the villagers' educations, HOPE provides additional social services such as clean water, health education, and economic opportunities. HOPE for Ariang now reaches approximately 3,000 students and 60 teachers in three schools through the Ariang Network of Schools program. There are plans to build a Mading School (the students currently meet under trees) and a high school so more students can complete grades 9-12 rather than having to go to boarding school which is financially out of reach for families. Currently HOPE for Ariang's high school sponsorship program (Scholars Empowerment Program) is able to support 21 students through high school. The graduates of HOPE for Ariang's Women Empowerment Program (WEP) are now operating small profitable businesses that are mainly involved in making school uniforms. Their impact on communities has been made possible by the financial contributions that HOPE for Ariang receives from its supporters. \$1 buys a notebook for a student, \$10 provides a full year of school supplies for a student, and \$600 pays for a student to attend high school for a year.
